The existing names were predominantly from Kannada and Tulu languages. In some places, it is a mixture of Kannada and Tulu names. Some of the names of these villages have a long history of several centuries.

Many representatives of various active Kannada cultural institutions have given representations to the Karnataka Border Area Development Authority requesting to stall the decision of making changes to the names of these villages.

In view of the above facts, I request you to kindly reconsider the proposed decision of changing names of some villages in Kasargod and Manjeshwara Taluks of Kasargod district in Kerala State.
